The Fort Wayne community was the spot for the first Interfaith Habitat for Humanity home build. After three years and many delays, the keys were handed over and a beautiful dedication was given for new homeowners, Asia and Brooklynne.

Habitat's chief executive officer, Justin Berger, said in his dedication, "We have different communities of faith that say, hey, we all may be different, but we all have the same desire to serve our neighbors and love on people who need a place to live. This is a culmination of those events; a couple of years of fundraising, and getting volunteers to come out to swing hammers and paint. Today, all those efforts are paying off."
